Precautions

Functions Of Keys





ON/OFF: Turn on or off the product



Power button

- In shutdown state: Long press the  button to start the device.

- During normal operation: Long press the  button to enter shutdown/restart; short press to turn off the screen.

- In screen - off state: Short press the  button to turn on the screen.



Volume +: Increase system volume

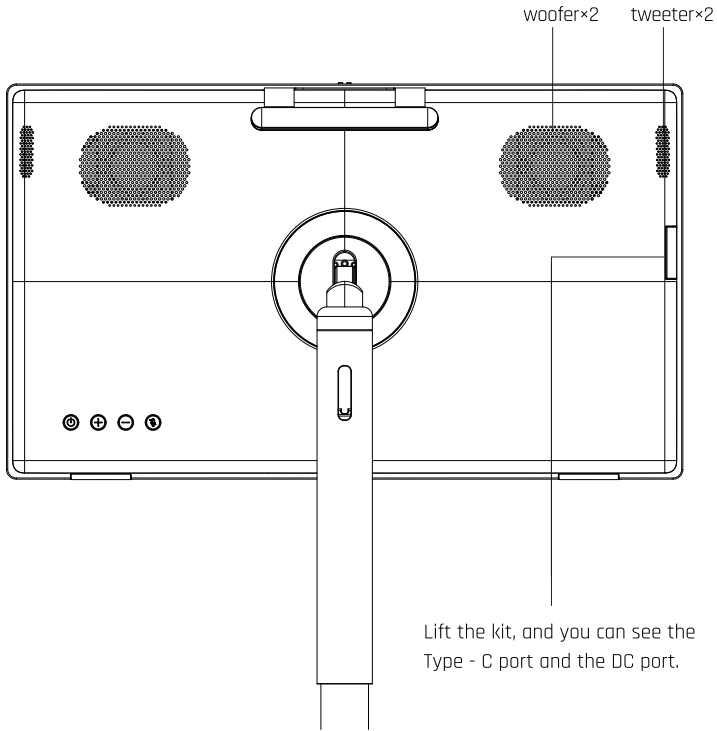


Volume -: Decrease system volume

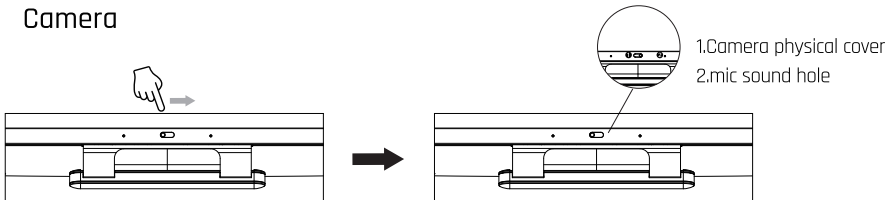
Battery

This product has a built-in battery and can be used for a period of time without connecting to other power sources. Please insert the adapter before attempting to power on for the first time or if it has not been used for a long time.

Type-C

Connect the Type-C cable to the Type-C port of this device and the Type-C interface of the external device respectively, and then functions such as Type-C transmission can be used.

Camera



Slide the top camera cover to open/cover the camera.

Basic Operations

Power-on/Standby

Upon first use, connect to the adapter and press the power button on the back case for 3 seconds to power on the device. During normal working, swipe down from the top edge, and drop-down menu appears. Click "☰ > ☰ Power off", then the product enters Powered off state. Press [Restart] can reboot the machine.

Touch Operation

- Click: Tap on the screen.
 - Click and hold: Tap on the screen for 2s or longer.
 - Swipe: Swipe on the screen up, down, left and right.
 - Drag: Tap and hold the target (e.g., an application) to be moved, then swipe to the desired position.
 - Spread/ Pinch: Place two fingers on the screen, then open or close these fingers to zoom in or out the content displayed on the screen.
- Note: After the screen turns off, you can choose either "Single tap to wake" or "Double tap to wake" from the Settings-Display menu to awaken the screen.
- Click "Settings > System > Gestures > System navigation" to select the system navigation mode.

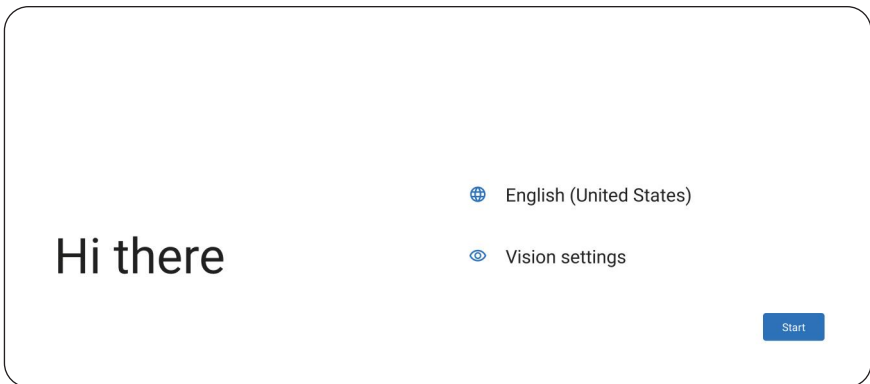
Attention:

- Whether the displayed content supports the zoom in/out function is related to the application. Please operate according to the actual condition.
- Avoid pressing the screen with force; where necessary, simply use your fingertip to tap on the desired item. If you wear gloves or use your fingernail to touch the screen, it is possible that the product cannot respond and be operated normally.
- If the screen is a little wet or too damp, the sensor cannot work normally when touching it.

Wi-Fi Connection

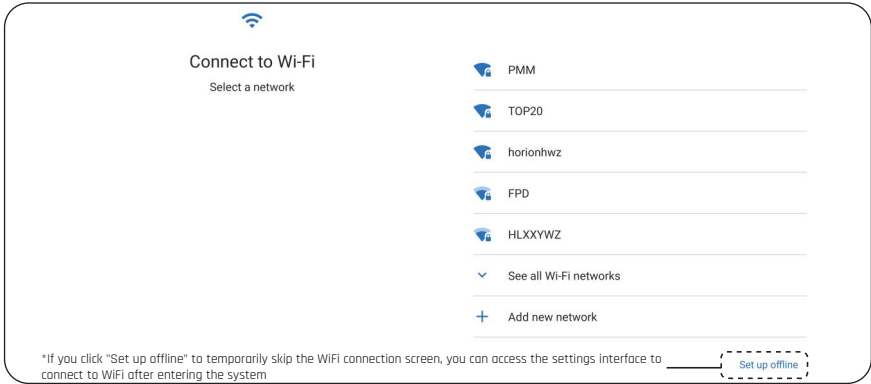
1. Connect at the power-on wizard

- After the MegPad is turned on for the first time or restored to factory settings, it enters the startup wizard interface

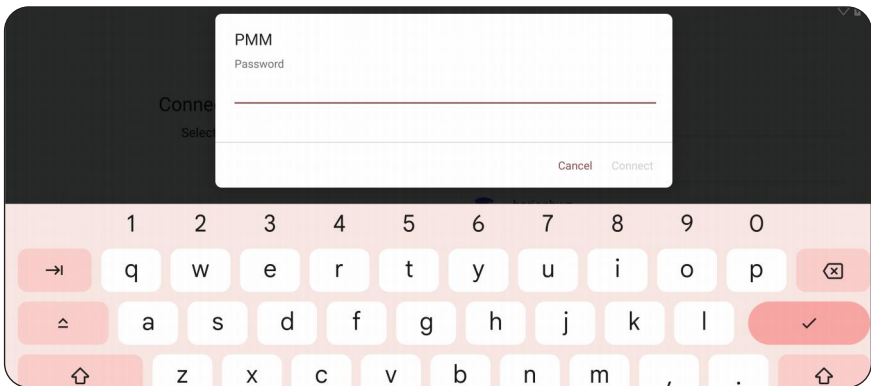

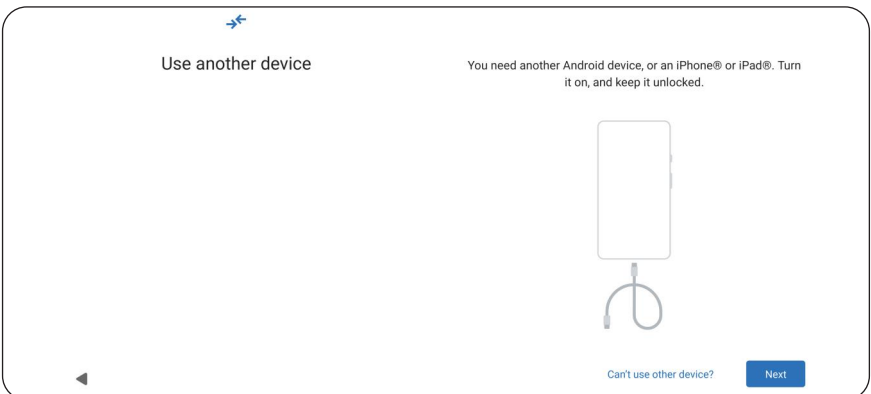
- After clicking **[Start]**, you will enter the Wi-Fi connection interface



- Tap the Wi-Fi network you wish to connect to. The Wi-Fi password input screen will appear. Enter the corresponding Wi-Fi password



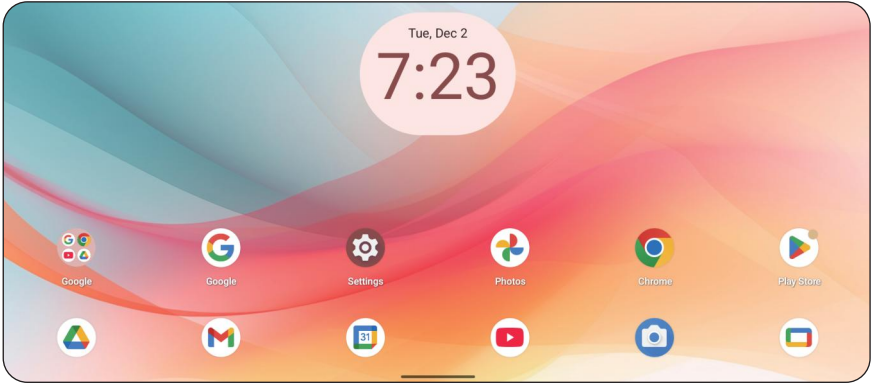
- After a successful connection, the following interface will appear (this interface may persist for several minutes). Subsequently, you will enter the data migration interface



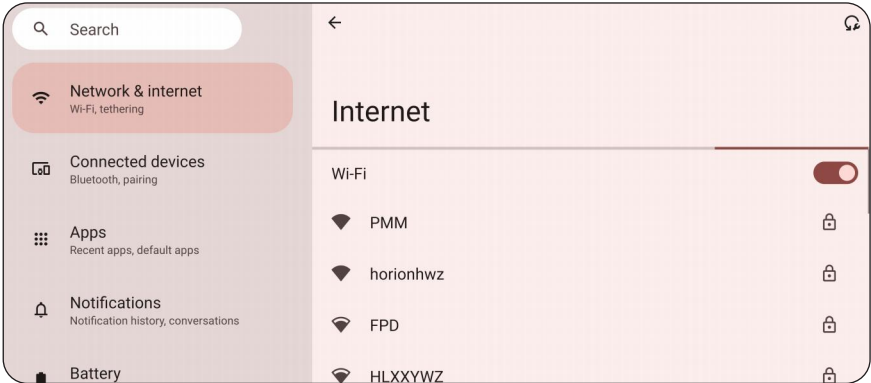

2.Connect to Wi-Fi in the settings

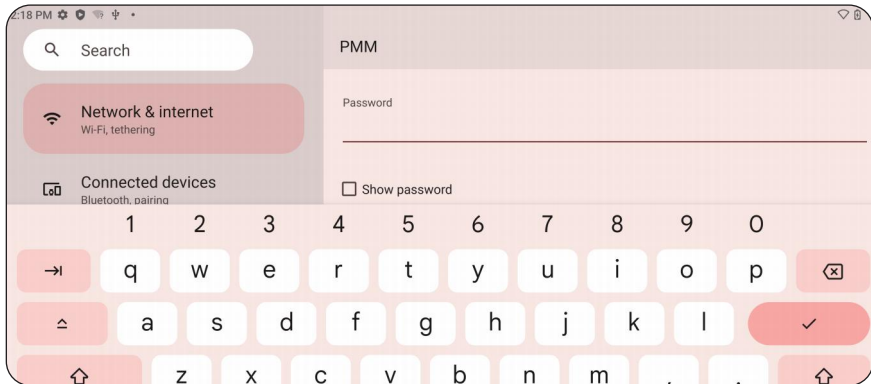
- Tap **[Settings]** on the main screen to enter the settings interface



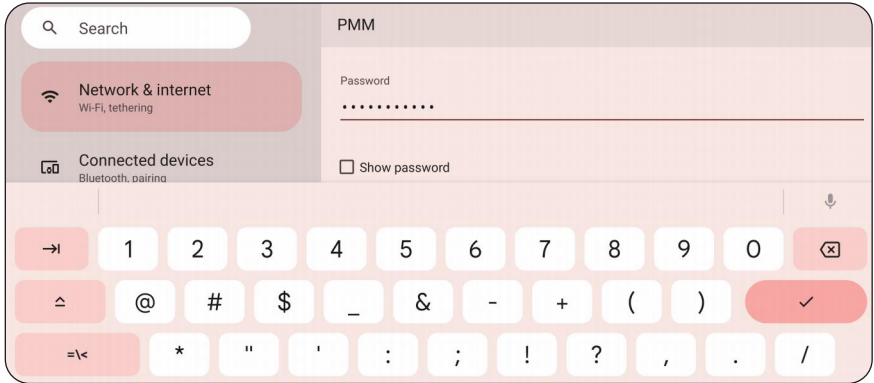
- Tap **[Network & Internet]**, then toggle the switch next to Wi-Fi (tap) to display the Wi-Fi list



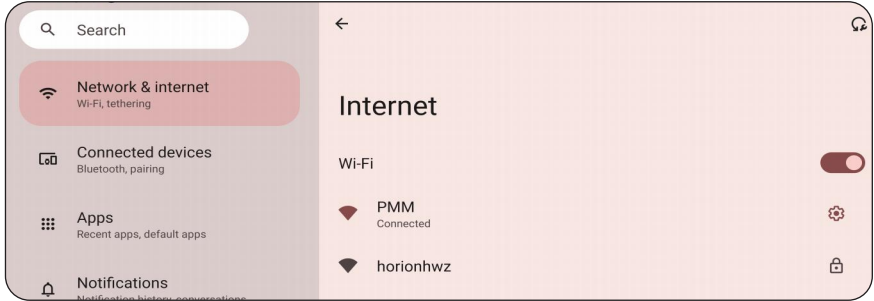
- Tap the Wi-Fi network you wish to connect to. Enter the password in the prompt that appears. After confirming the correct password, the connection will be established

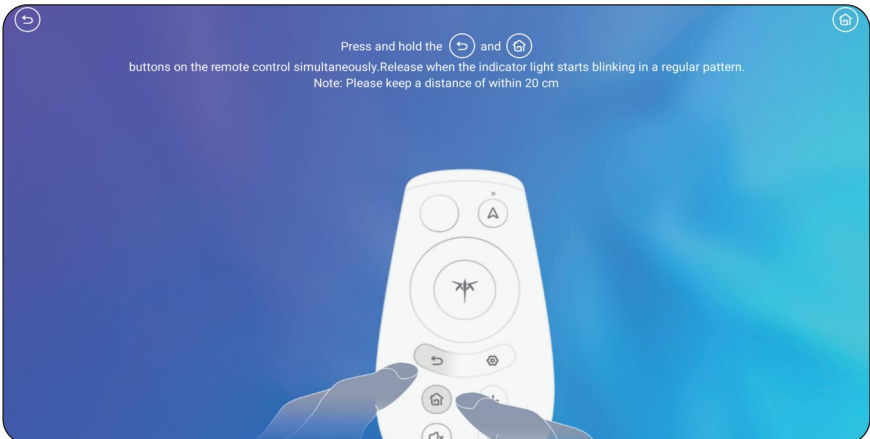
- Connection successful indicator appears, displaying "connected" under the corresponding Wi-Fi network

- The final page of the startup wizard displays the remote control pairing interface, shown below



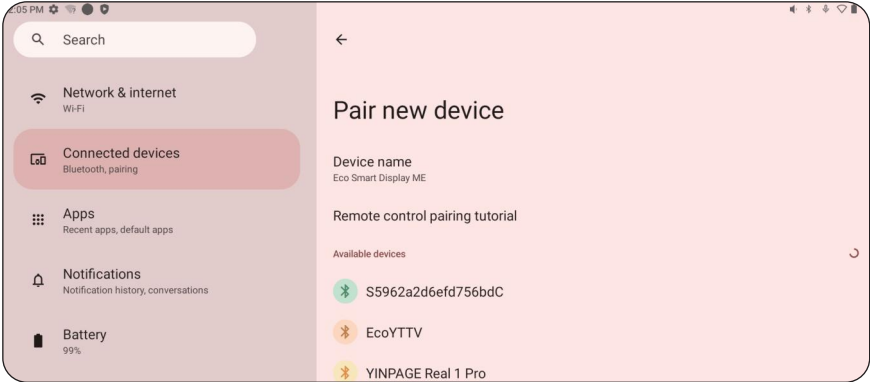
- Follow the prompts on the remote pairing interface to complete the pairing process and enter the system home screen

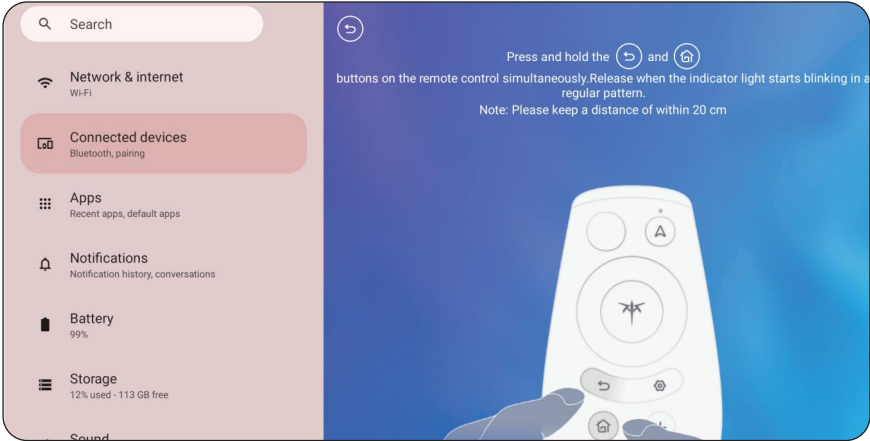
If you skip the Bluetooth connection by selecting the home icon “🏠” during the setup wizard, you can later pair the Bluetooth remote control in the settings

2.Go to Settings to pair

- Tap **[Settings]** on the main screen to enter the Settings interface. Tap **[Connected devices]** and select **[Pair new device]**



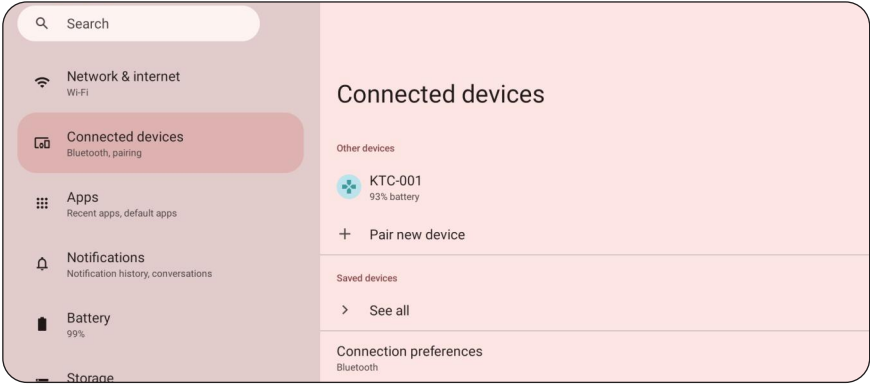
- Next, click **[Remote control pairing tutorial]** to enter the remote control pairing interface as shown below



- Follow the prompts on the remote control pairing interface to complete the pairing process

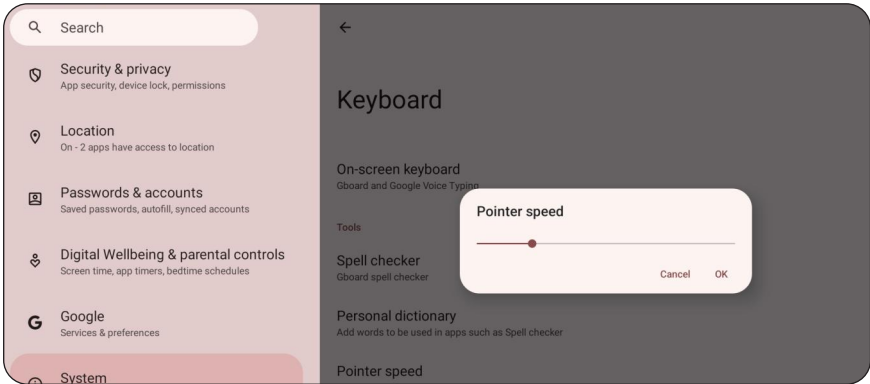

*Note: 1. When the remote control and MegPad are paired, pressing any button on the remote will cause the indicator light to flash. If the indicator light does not flash when pressing the remote, check whether the remote control and MegPad are in a paired state



2. If the remote control is in mouse-over mode, the MegPad will wake up when the mouse pointer hovers over it. If you encounter the MegPad waking up immediately after going to sleep, please disable mouse-over functionality

3. If you find the remote control's mouse pointer moving too fast or too slow, you can enter the settings and click **[System-Keyboard-Pointer speed]** to adjust the pointer speed to your preference

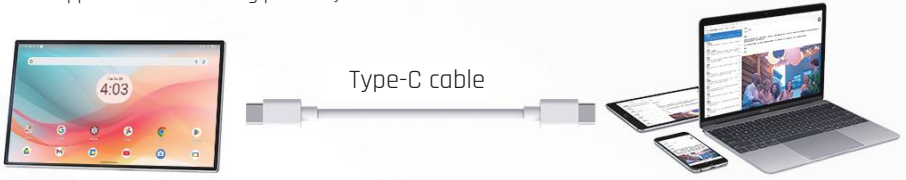

Screen Mirroring

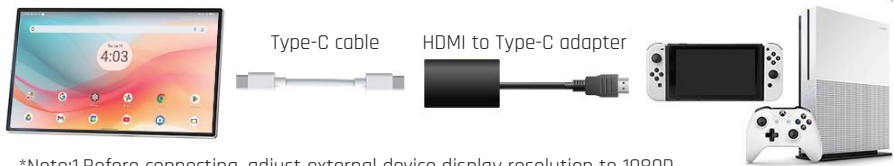
1.Wired screen mirroring

- For external devices that support Type-C screen mirroring (iPhone requires a series of 15 or above to support it), they can be directly connected to MegPad through a dual head Type-C cable (the cable needs to support screen mirroring protocol)

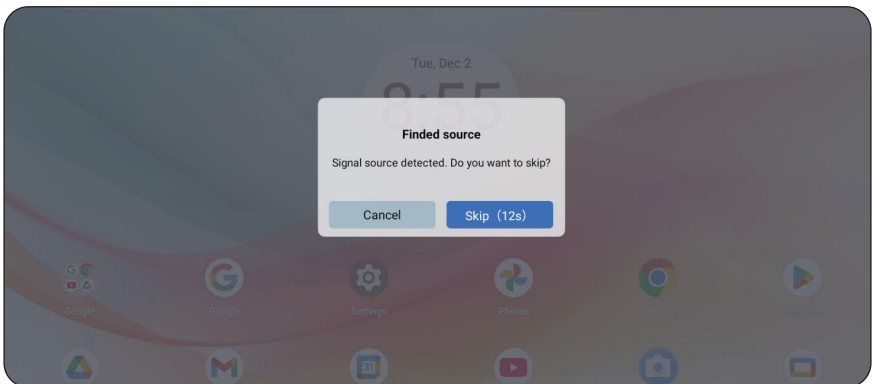


*Note:The Type-C cable is to be purchased separately.

- For external devices with only HDMI interfaces, they need to be connected through an HDMI to Type-C signal converter



- *Note:1.Before connecting, adjust external device display resolution to 1080P
- 2.Adapter must support HDMI 2.1 to Dp 1.4 protocol (for 4K@120Hz output) and 48Gbps bandwidth
- 3.After connection, MegPad will automatically pop up the source signal (this process is expected to take 10-20 seconds)

2. Wireless Screen Mirroring

- Swipe on the main interface to find the Cast application and open it - Wireless screen mirroring supports 4 modes. Choose the desired screen mirroring method based on your own situation

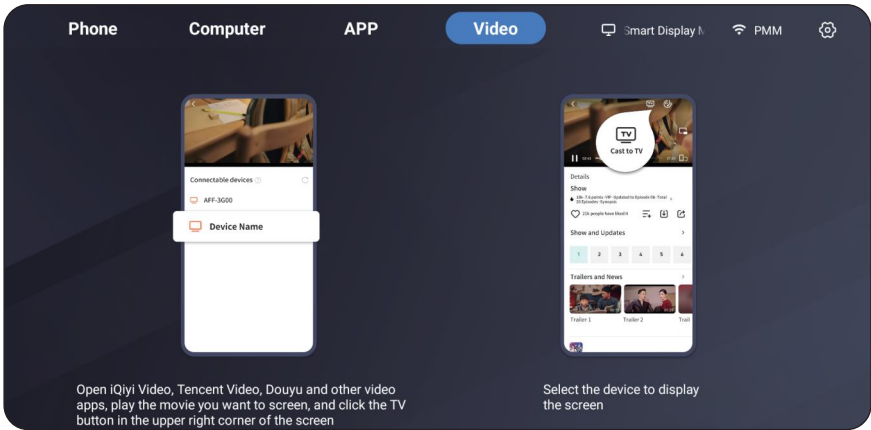

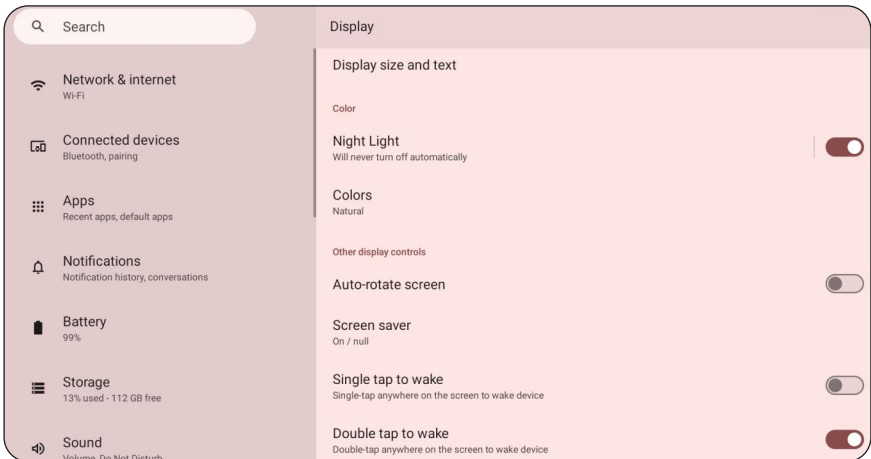

Single double-click wake-up

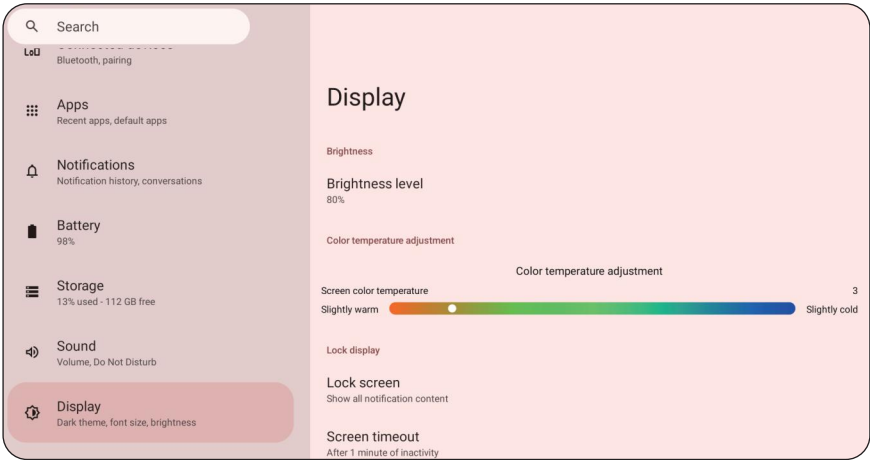
- MegPad supports clicking to wake up while in sleep mode. You can enter Settings-Display and select [Single tap to wake/Double tap to wake]. Enabling this feature will increase power consumption and shorten MegPad's standby time

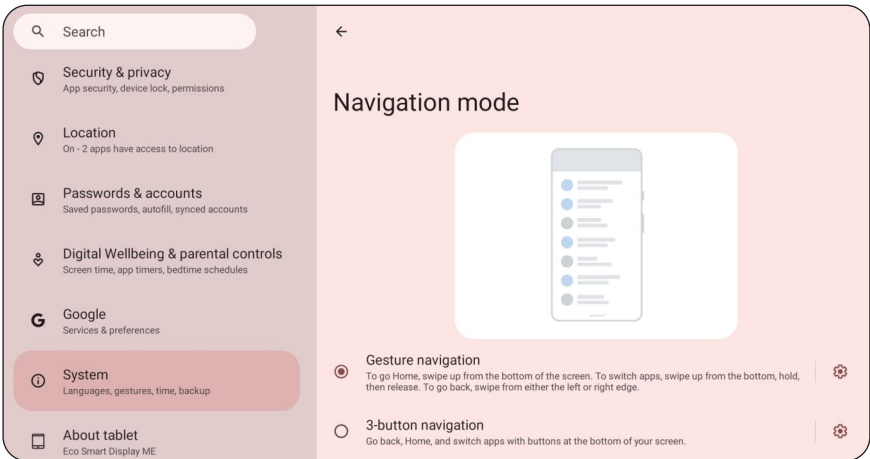
Color Temperature Adjustment

- MegPad can adjust different color temperatures according to your preferences. Go to Settings - Display
Screen color temperature to choose the color temperature you want, with a total of 15 settings



Navigation Bar Mode

- MegPad currently supports two navigation modes: Gesture navigation/3-button navigation. You can enter Settings - System Navigation mode to choose from

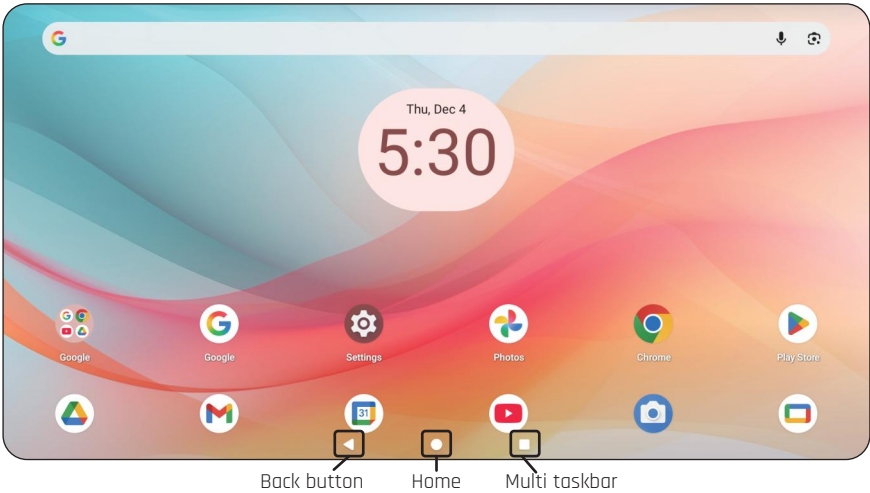

- The Gesture navigation interface is as follows. In this mode, sliding from the left side of the screen to the right will activate the return function, while sliding up from the bottom of the screen will open the multi taskbar



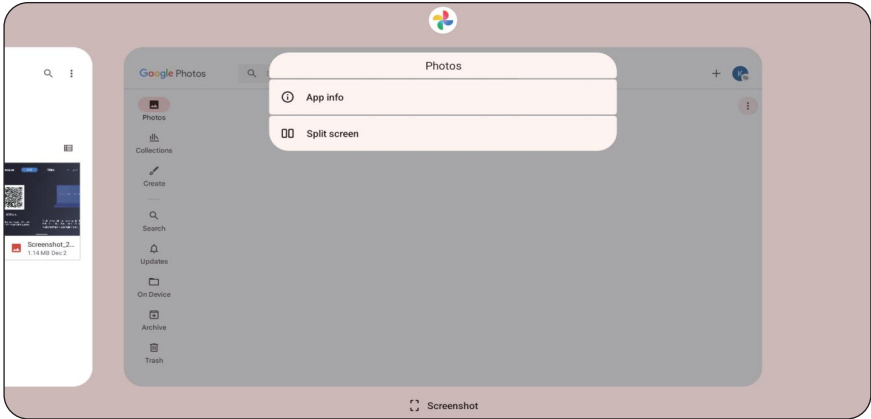
- The 3-button navigation interface is as follows, with function keys at the bottom in this mode



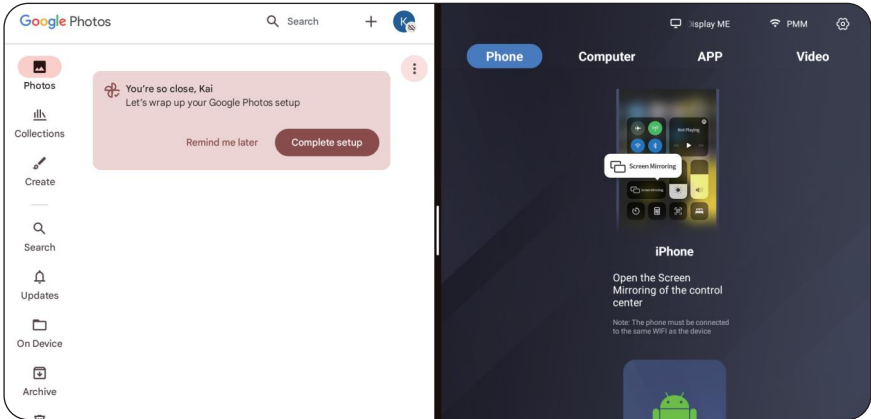

Application Split Screen

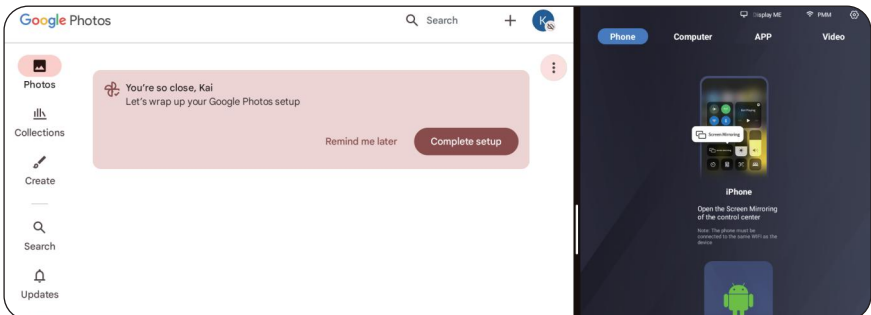
- The MegPad supports left and right screen usage for two applications; Open the applications that you need to split the screen separately, so that both applications can appear in the multi taskbar
- Select one of the apps you want to split in the multi taskbar and long press the icon for that app above



- Select the other app you want to split the screen with and click on its icon above, and you will display both apps on the screen at the same time



- You can also adjust the split screen size of the two apps by dragging the white line in the middle

Low blue light

The light emitted by the screen contains blue light, and keeping the eyes on the screen for long periods of time will not only bring visual fatigue, but also may cause eye diseases. Using the low blue light function will reduce blue light and reduce eye fatigue.

This product uses low blue light hardware.

Eye care recommendations :

- 1) Do not use the product for a long time without interruption, avoid overuse of the eyes, it is recommended that you take a 10 minute break for every 30 minutes of use.
- 2) When taking a break, you can relax your eyes by looking at distant scenery.
- 3) When taking a break, do eye exercises to relax your eyes.
- 4) Infants under the age of 2 should not watch the screen.
- 5) According to your own needs, you can turn on the eye protection mode through the drop-down menu, or enter "Setting - Display" to make settings.
